



Batch Number Decoding

Example

GS15C74149

G – This is for the country of manufacture . G stands for Great Britain

S – This is the factory where goods are produced . S stands for Stafford . L will stand for Leicester .

15 – This is the year of manufacture . 15 stands for 2015

C – Stands for the month of manufacture . From January until September a numbering system from 1-9 is used, after which a lettering system is then used

1 – January

2 – February

3 – March

4 – April

5 – May

6 – June

7- July

8 – August

9- September

A – October

B – November

C – December

The last 5 Digits are then the actual Batch number for the product . So above Batch Number was made in Stafford in Great Britain in December 2015

Example of Numbering – GS16687295

This batch Was made in Stafford in Great Britain in June 2016 .
