

Batch Number Decoding

GS1	-	. //	 /I U

- G This is for the country of manufacture . G stands for Great Britain
- $S-\mbox{This}$ is the factory where goods are produced . S stands for Stafford . L will stand for Leicester .
- 15 This is the year of manufacture . 15 stands for 2015
- $C-Stands \ for the month of manufacture . From January until September a numbering system from 1-9 is used, after which a lettering system is then used$
- 1 January
- 2 February
- 3 March
- 4 April
- 5 May
- 6 June
- 7- July
- 8 August
- 9- September
- A October
- B November
- C December

The last 5 Digits are then the actual Batch number for the product . So above Batch Number was made in Stafford in Great Britain in December 2015
